## **CATIE Center Level Up Cohort Track: Participant Timeline**

### Application opens for participants to apply (November)

- 1. Live in the U.S. or U.S. territories
- 2. Possess 3+ years of interpreting experience
- 3. Possess a B.A. Degree or Equivalent
- 4. Possess a background and interest in interpreting in Healthcare.
- 5. Have access to appropriate technology for online learning and video conferencing capabilities, e.g., Zoom, GoReact.
- 6. Possess a willingness to work with consumers and colleagues from all backgrounds, including individuals from traditionally underrepresented and marginalized communities including Black and Indigenous People of Color (BIPOC), Heritage Language Signers, and interpreters from rural areas.

### Each cohort is composed of 35 randomly selected participants.

# Program Components

Includes two portions that run simultaneously: the educational phase and the experiential learning phase. A total of 126 hours over 8 months running from Jan. 2nd, 2024 to July 31, 2024.

#### **Educational Phase 96 Hours**

All work is completed on the learning management system called Canvas.

- 8 online asynchronous modules- two taken at a time
- Self-reflection and assignments

\*If you have completed these two modules while enrolled in a self-directed track you will need to complete them again while in the Cohort Track.

### **Experiential Learning Portion 30 Hours**

All work is completed on GoReact platform and other video platforms.

- 15 hours of mock interpreting work which includes 5 asynchronous mock interpreting scenarios which focus on body systems and healthcare interactions.
  - Self-analysis
  - Feedback from Community Assessors and Interpreting Mentors
- 10 hours of case consult
  - Completed online with an assigned Supervisor
- 5 hours of observation of healthcare interpreting scenarios
